

59. REQUEST FOR MEAT INSPECTION***DESCRIPTION of the SERVICE:***

Before and after any animal or fowl is slaughtered for human consumption, the meat inspectors from the City Veterinary Office will determine whether the animal or fowl is fit for consumption.

REQUIREMENTS:

- * Veterinary Shipping Permit / Veterinary Health Certificate
- * Certificate of Ownership of large animals

FEES:

- * Post Mortem fee—10 centavos /kilo

PROCEDURE :

STEPS	PROCESSING/ RESPONSE TIME	PERSON- IN- CHARGE
1. The client brings the animal to the city slaughterhouse		
2. Conducts the ante mortem inspection	10 minutes	NESTOR UMALI <i>Meat Inspector I</i>
3. Conducts the post mortem examination after the animal is slaughtered and marks the carcass signifying fit for human consumption	10 minutes	HILARIO KATIGBAK <i>Meat Inspector III</i>
